The 6th, 7th and 8th Grade Curriculum will consists of 3 booklets for each grade. The 6th grade will have these major themes: Sacraments, Old Testament and The 10 Commandments. The 7th and 8th grade will have these major themes: Church History, Creed and Discipleship. All groups will learn about the past of our Catholic Faith through either the Old Testament or The History of the Catholic Church. Then we will discover what our faith and beliefs are and finally, how Catholics practice their faith in word and action.

1st Quarter

6th Grade will learn in-depth about the 7 Sacraments of the Catholic Church.

7th and 8th grade will learn about the early origins of the Catholic Church in the beginning with the Apostles and the spread of the Faith.

2nd Quarter

6th Grade will finish The Seven Sacraments and will learn about the Old Testament starting with creation in Genesis, Moses and the 10 Commandments, Abraham and the 12 Tribes and the Kings through David.

7th and 8th Grade will continue to learn about the History of The Catholic Church through the Councils along with the challenges and obstacles to the Faith.

3rd Quarter

6th Grade will continue with the Old Testament and begin the 10 Commandments.

The 7th and 8th grade will study the Apostle's Creed and its basis for the Catholic Faith and Beliefs.

4th Quarter

6th Grade will finish learning about the 10 Commandments and how to follow them in today's world.

7th and 8th grade will learn about Discipleship and what it means to be one of Jesus' followers in today's world.

As part of being a follower of Jesus students in the Jr. High will be asked to do 20 hours of volunteer work throughout the year. Students may choose to volunteer in a elementary classroom at a study hall during the week, help with the elementary recess playtime (during lunch once a week) or help out for the many fund raisers throughout the year (bingo, Christmas Bazaar, any of the many others).
